Professional Experience and Development

A well-written CV* and a personal statement essay written in English.

Academic history

All official transcripts received from previous years spent in higher education.

Recommendations

Completed professional and academic reference forms.

Proficiency in English

Demonstrated by a minimum TOEFL score of 550 or IELTS score of 6.5

*Candidates with two years of professional experience or more are highly sought-after.

A number of scholarships are available in the form of full or partial tuition fee waivers. These scholarships are limited, competitive and only granted on a case by case basis.
